



1. Read **Matthew 4:12-22, Isaiah 9:1-4, Psalm 27:1, 4-9, 1 Corinthians 1:18-31** / 2. Where was the place where Jesus, who was tested by the devil in the wilderness, first began his ministry? Why did Jesus choose that place? How did Matthew express this place, and what does it mean? / 3. What was the message of Jesus' gospel, and what was the meaning of this message? Who were the first people who called out Jesus, declaring the message of the gospel? Why did Jesus call them out first? And how did they react? / 6. Looking at the reactions of the disciples that Jesus first called, what can be applied to my life?
